

# TUITION CREDIT PROGRAM

## Tuition Credit Program for Periods of Interconnected (Remote) Learning during 2020-21

We recognize that periods of Interconnected Learning require parental involvement in our students' education at varying levels depending on a student's age. As a way to acknowledge the important work parents do in assisting us as we deliver AWS's curriculum to their child(ren)/our student(s) from a distance, we created a tuition credit program.

Credits for the 2021-22 school year will be determined at the end of the 2020-21 school year. Credits will be prorated by the number of full weeks (not to exceed twelve weeks) of Interconnected Learning we have during the year.

The following percentages of each student's 2020-21 Adjusted Tuition amount will be credited towards enrollment at AWS for the 2021-22 school year:

- 35% credit for Early Childhood & Grade 1
- 25% credit for Grades 2/3
- 15% credit for Grades 4/5
- 10% credit for Grades 6/7

For example, if we had a total of 6 full weeks of Interconnected Learning for the school year, a Grade 1 family with an Adjusted Tuition amount of \$8,000 would receive a credit of \$525 to be used towards 2021-22 tuition.

\$8,000	6	32	$\$8,000 \times 6/32$ = \$1,500	35%	\$525
