



2018-19 Enrollment Timeline

January 1 st	2018-19 BISON Scholarship online application process opens .
January 22 th	2018-19 Enrollment Package is mailed to current families by this date.
February 5 th or 20 th	The March tuition payment for current families will be due in February. The 2018-19 registration fee has been moved from February to March. March is now the " skip" month in FACTS with no regular 2017-18 tuition payment due.
February 8 th	Deadline for applying for tuition assistance and uploading financial materials online to FACTS. Applications for current families completed after this date will have \$500 deducted from any tuition assistance award. New families should apply for tuition assistance when they apply for admission. Families without online access may contact Sarah Jozwiak, Business Manager, at 655-2029 x112 or sjozwiak@aurorawaldorfschool.org to arrange for the use of a computer and/or to have materials scanned and uploaded to FACTS.
February 28 th	2018-19 BISON Scholarship online application process closes .
March 1 st	Tuition Contracts, transportation forms, and health appraisals are mailed to current AWS families.
March 19 th	Enrollment Deadline: Families who turn in their signed contract, set up their FACTS Payment Plan, and pay the registration fee by this date, or by the date printed on a contract, (whichever is later) will have their registration fee credited towards their last 2018-19 tuition payment.
March 19 th	2% Tuition Discount and Registration Fee Waived if tuition and supply fee are paid in full by check or cash by this date.
March 19 th	Transportation Forms due for 2018-19 bus riders.
April 19 th	1.5% Tuition Discount if tuition, supply fee, and registration fee are paid in full by check or cash by this date.
June 1 st	Health Appraisals and updated immunization records are due.
July 5 th or 20 th	First FACTS payment due for the 2018-19 school year.
August 27 th	Information on AWS Portal for each student and household is reviewed and updated by parents no later than this date.
