



## Raffle 2019-2020

### Sales & Collection Information

Please read all the information below and on the back of this page to make sure you understand the instructions for selling tickets and returning ticket stubs and funds.

- Each family is tracked by the office according to the numbers listed on tickets. Families that only have a three-day nursery student are required to sell 15 tickets per parent. All other families are required to sell 25 tickets per parent. Ticket obligations are per parent, not per student.
- Make sure that whenever a ticket is sold, the buyer information is filled out onto the ticket stub (name, email). All ticket stubs returned to the office must have the buyer contact information.
- Ticket stubs and funds can be returned to the office at any time. If you are sending stubs and funds to school with your child, they **MUST** come to the office with a filled out deposit form to avoid lost stubs or funds. The office also will not accept any ticket stubs without funds.
- Ticket stubs and funds are the responsibility of the family, not the office until a deposit form is filled out by the office, noting collected funds.
- NEW THIS YEAR – There will be a monthly internal drawing to encourage ticket sales. For every five tickets sold, you will have an entry into the internal drawing.
  - November 26 collection/early December drawing - Choice of 2 Winter Faire admissions or 1 AWS holiday ornament
  - December 20 collection/early January drawing - Choice of 2 quarts of soup or an AWS t-shirt
  - January 31 collection/early February drawing - Choice of 2 quarts of soup or a jar of local honey
  - All remaining tickets are due in February.

**All ticket stubs and funds must be returned to the office no later than Friday, February 28, 2020.**

## **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS:**

**Q: What is the friend-raising exception?**

**A:** Refer a family that enrolls a student, and your family's raffle obligation will be minimized or released entirely. Please contact the office for further details.

**Q: What is the cost of each raffle ticket?**

**A:** \$20.00

**Q: Who can I sell raffle tickets to?**

**A:** Anyone over the age of 18! The tickets can be sold to family, friends, coworkers, or even the person in line next to you at the coffee shop or bakery. ☺

**Q: How many tickets does each family need to sell?**

**A:** Families with only a 3-Day Nursery student are required to sell 15 tickets per parent (\$300.00 per parent). All other families are required to sell 25 tickets per parent (\$500.00 per parent). Ticket sales are per parent, not per student.

**Q: Where/when will the raffle drawing take place?**

**A:** Saturday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, during the AWS Artisan Auction at the Roycroft Inn, East Aurora.

**Q: Do I need to be in attendance at the drawing to win?**

**A:** No, winners that are not in attendance at the drawing will be contacted by phone and email.

**Q: What happens if I do not sell all my tickets?**

**A:** If a family is not able to sell all the tickets provided to them, they will be required to purchase the remainder of the tickets. Any money paid to the school in lieu of selling tickets is not tax-exempt. Any tickets purchased by the family should be filled out and entered into the drawing for chances to win!
