Buyers can fill out this form to order tickets and send it back to you or to the office directly. This form is not necessary if the buyer is taking one of your provided tickets.

- **Raffle Monthly Deposit Forms and White Envelope** (4 copies)
When you submit ticket stubs and funds to the office, this form should be filled in completely and included. *New This Year - You do not need to return the green envelope with your ticket stubs.*

- **Ticket Tracking Form**
This is attached to the envelope and for your reference only. Use this to track the tickets you've sold.
